**AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING A TASK FORCE TO CONDUCT CLEARING OPERATIONS ON OVERLOADED AND HAZARDOUS POLES IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, grants Local Government Units (LGUs) the authority to promote general welfare, including maintaining public safety and ensuring that public utilities and infrastructure do not pose a risk to the public;

**WHEREAS**, unauthorized attachments and installations on utility poles within the Municipality of Bayambang have become a public safety concern, contributing to the overloading of poles, the risk of falling infrastructure, and the obstruction of streets and pedestrian pathways

**WHEREAS**, DILG Memorandum Circular No 2024-122, titled "Creation of a Task Force to Conduct Clearing Operations on Overloaded and Hazardous Poles," mandates all LGUs to create a task force to regularly conduct monitoring and assessment ensuring that poles are being utilized according to their design and load capacity,

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to ensure that all poles and installations are used with the approval of their respective Pole Owners and that they comply with existing regulations such as Executive Order No. 32, Series of 2023, titled "Streamlining the Permitting Process for the Construction of Telecommunications and Internet Infrastructure," which mandates proper management and utilization of poles and infrastructure;

**WHEREAS**, to address these concerns, coordinated effort among various LGU Departments, public utilities, and stakeholders is necessary to promptly remove unauthorized attachments, reduce the risks posed by overloaded and hazardous poles, and ensure compliance with all relevant safety and infrastructure regulations,

**WHEREAS**, to ensure continuity and enhance productivity, it is necessary to reconstitute the task force particularly to replace members who have been transferred or been reassigned, thereby enabling the unit to operate more efficiently and effectively.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:**

**SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE TASK FORCE.** The Task Force shall perform the following functions:

1. Establish a system for the recording, monitoring and assessment of poles, wires and cables within the municipality that require maintenance, repair, and/or due for replacement,
2. Ensure that Pole users have secured consent and approval from Pole Owners and are compliant with existing regulations, prior cables, and other foreign attachments to issuing a permit to install wires,
3. Ensure immediate removal of wires, cables, and foreign attachments that are:
  - 3.1. No longer required
  - 3.2. No longer in use
  - 3.3. Not authorized
  - 3.4. Not installed in compliance with regulations and standards provided by law
  - 3.5. Hazardous

- 3.6. Threaten public safety
- 3.7. required to be removed by any competent authority
4. Conduct clearing operations and prioritize areas which require immediate repair, rectification, removal of illegal, unauthorized, unused and/or retired wires, cables, and other foreign attachments.
  5. Prepare reports to be submitted every quarter to the Office of the Mayor and the Office of the Municipal Administrator. The report should detail the progress of clearing operations, including a list of removed unauthorized attachments and measures taken to address overloaded or hazardous poles.
  6. Propose methods/procedures to improve processes of this Order to the DILG.
  7. Conduct a meeting for continued monitoring and updating relevant to the implementation of clearing operations.
  8. Develop a communication strategy to effectively disseminate information regarding clearing operations, the risks of unauthorized attachments and the importance of compliance with pole regulations.
  9. Exercise other functions necessary for the purpose of this Order.

**SECTION 3. FUNDING.** Funds for the implementation of this Order shall be sourced from the budget of the Municipal Engineering Office and other available sources, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

**SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately, and remain in force, unless otherwise modified or revoked.

This Executive Order shall be disseminated and implemented accordingly.
