**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 94**

**“AN EXECUTIVE ORDER IMPOSING A CURFEW FOR MINORS AGED SEVENTEEN (17) YEARS OLD AND BELOW WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG”**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991,” provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and promote the general welfare of its constituents;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Bayambang recognizes the importance of protecting minors from potential harm and criminal influences, particularly during nighttime hours; **WHEREAS**, curfew regulations are proven deterrents to juvenile delinquency and are essential in fostering public safety, discipline, and parental responsibility;

**WHEREAS**, it is the duty of the local government to ensure a safe and peaceful community, especially for its younger constituents;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Mary Clare Judith Phyllis Jose Quiambao, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**SECTION 1. CURFEW HOURS**

A curfew is hereby imposed for all minors aged seventeen (17) years old and below within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Bayambang from 10:00 P.M. to 4:00 A.M. daily.

**SECTION 2. EXEMPTIONS**

Minors shall be exempted from the curfew hours if:

- a. Accompanied by a parent or legal guardian;
- b. Attending or returning from a school-sanctioned or religious activity, provided proof is presented;
- c. Engaged in lawful employment and can present a valid work permit or certificate from an employer;
- d. In cases of emergency or other justifiable reasons, subject to verification.

### **SECTION 3. RESPONSIBILITY OF PARENTS/GUARDIANS**

Parents and guardians shall exercise responsibility over the whereabouts of their minor children. They may be held administratively liable for repeated violations by their children, subject to due process.

### **SECTION 4. ENFORCEMENT**

The Philippine National Police (PNP), Barangay Officials, and designated Municipal Personnel are hereby directed to strictly enforce this Executive Order. Apprehended minors shall be brought to the nearest barangay hall or police station and turned over to their parents or guardians. Counseling or intervention by the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) may be conducted as necessary.

### **SECTION 5. PENALTIES**

Violations of this Order shall be subject to the following measures:

- First Offense: Warning and documentation by authorities;
- Second Offense: Notification and seminar for parent/guardian and the minor;
- Third and Subsequent Offenses: Imposition of appropriate intervention measures as may be determined by the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO).


### **SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE**

If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

### **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon approval and publication in a conspicuous place within the municipality and dissemination to all barangays.
