"AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE AGRICULTURAL AND FISHERIES MECHANIZATION COMMITTEE (AFMech) THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the agricultural and fisheries sectors are vital components of our economy, contributing significantly to food security, rural development, and employment generation, and it is imperative to ensure the proper utilization and management of mechanization technologies to maximize their benefits and minimize adverse impacts on the environment and local communities;

WHEREAS, local governments play a crucial role in the development and implementation of policies and programs for adoption of mechanization technologies in agriculture and fisheries that can enhance productivity, efficiency, and competitiveness of these sectors:

WHEREAS, the LGU-Bayambang aims to address food security, poverty alleviation, and sustainable growth through increased farm income and productivity of our farmers through the development and implementation of modern, appropriate and cost-effective and environmentally-safe agricultural fisheries machinery and equipment;

WHEREAS, the LGUs, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", shall undertake applied research, extension, dispersal, management and regulation of agricultural and fisheries machinery and equipment, including the collection of fees;

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 33 of R.A No. 10601, otherwise known as the Agricultural and Fisheries Mechanization (AFMech) Law states that the LGUs, through an ordinance, shall formulate, in consultation with the Department of Agriculture (DA), and implement their respective provincial, city and municipal agricultural and fishery mechanization plans as a vital component of their respective local development plans; These Local Agricultural and Fishery Mechanization Plans (LAFMPs) shall form part of the National Agricultural and Fishery Mechanization;


NOW THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO

SECTION 2. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The committee shall be responsible for performing the following functions and responsibilities:

- a) Develop and implement policies, programs, and projects that promote the adoption and sustainable use of mechanization technologies in agriculture and fisheries;
- b) Facilitate access to mechanization services, equipment, and financing mechanisms for smallholder farmers and fisherfolk;
- c) Conduct research and studies to assess the impact of mechanization on agricultural and fisheries productivity, sustainability, and socio-economic development;
- d) Provide capacity building and training activities to enhance the skills and knowledge of farmers, fisherfolk, and other stakeholders in mechanized farming and fishing techniques;
- e) Monitor and evaluate the implementation of mechanization-related initiatives and recommend adjustments or improvements as necessary; and
- f) Coordinate with relevant government agencies, non-governmental organizations, and other stakeholders to ensure synergy and complementarity in mechanization efforts.

SECTION 3. MEETINGS. The Agricultural and Fisheries Mechanization Committee (AFMech) shall meet regularly every quarter of the year at a date, time and venue agreed upon by members, and/or as necessary to discuss updates, issues, and matters, concerning the agricultural and fisheries mechanization program of the municipality.

A staff member of the Municipal Agriculture Office shall be designated as Secretary during the meeting/s. Minutes of Meeting and pertinent documents shall be under the care of the Vice-Chairperson (Municipal Agriculturist) of the Committee.

SECTION 4. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
