### MANDATING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF "TASK FORCE DISIPLINA" IN ALL SEVENTY-SEVEN (77) BARANGAYS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers all Local Government Units (LGUs) to promote the general welfare and ensure the effective and efficient delivery of basic services;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Bayambang has enacted several ordinances promoting discipline, public order, safety, environmental protection, proper road use, and responsible citizenship;

**WHEREAS**, despite the existence of these local laws, challenges persist in maintaining order in public spaces, reducing traffic hazards, preventing waste-related violations, enforcing anti-smoking policies, regulating stray animals, and addressing other community concerns;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Unit of Bayambang launched Task Force Disiplina (TFD) as a dedicated enforcement and monitoring mechanism to ensure compliance with municipal ordinances and to promote a culture of discipline throughout the municipality;

**WHEREAS**, expanding the implementation of Task Force Disiplina to all seventy-seven (77) barangays is necessary to strengthen grassroots enforcement, ensure uniform compliance with local ordinances, and foster community-wide cooperation in creating a clean, orderly, and safe municipality;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO**, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

#### SECTION 1. MANDATE FOR IMPLEMENTATION

All seventy-seven (77) barangays of the Municipality of Bayambang are hereby mandated to implement Task Force Disiplina (TFD) within their respective jurisdictions. Each barangay shall actively support, coordinate with, and enforce all directives issued under this Executive Order and related municipal ordinances.

#### SECTION 2. SCOPE OF IMPLEMENTATION

The barangay-based Task Force Disiplina shall enforce, monitor, and ensure compliance with the following ordinances and regulations, among others: *Baley ko, Pawilen ko, Aroen ko, tan Tulungan ko"*

A barangay Task Force Disiplina shall strictly carry out enforcement activities, documentation, citation issuance, and coordination with the Central Task Force Disiplina under the LGU.

### **SECTION 3. CREATION OF BARANGAY TASK FORCE DISIPLINA**

Each barangay shall establish its own Barangay Task Force Disiplina, composed of:

Punong Barangay – Chairperson

Barangay Kagawad on Peace and Order – Vice Chairperson

Barangay Tanods – Enforcement Team

Barangay Health Workers / BNS Representatives – Support Unit

Representatives from local organizations (as needed)

The team shall work closely with the LGU Central Task Force Disiplina and follow operational guidelines set by the Municipal Government.

### **SECTION 4. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Barangay Task Force Disiplina shall:

- a. Conduct regular roving, inspection, and monitoring within the barangay;
- b. Enforce municipal ordinances and issue barangay-level citations;

- c. Coordinate with the Municipal TFD for major violations or escalations;
- d. Ensure cleanliness, orderliness, and unobstructed public spaces;
- e. Assist in information dissemination and barangay assemblies;
- f. Document violations and submit reports to the Municipal TFD Secretariat.

## **SECTION 5. SUPPORT FROM MUNICIPAL OFFICES**

All relevant municipal offices—including the BPSO, MENRO, Veterinary Office, MSWDO, MDRRMO, BPLO, Engineering Office, Municipal Information Office, and others—shall provide technical, logistical, and enforcement support to barangays to ensure successful implementation.

## **SECTION 6. INFORMATION, EDUCATION, AND COMMUNICATION (IEC)**

The Municipal Information Office, in coordination with barangays, shall conduct awareness campaigns, install signages, and assist in public information activities to ensure understanding and compliance with TFD rules and ordinances.

## **SECTION 7. FUNDING**

Barangays shall allocate funds from their Peace and Order Budget, 20% Development Fund (if applicable), and other lawful sources to support TFD operations. Additional support may be granted by the Municipal Government subject to availability of funds and SB approval.

## **SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE**

If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid, the remaining portions shall continue to be in full force and effect.

## **SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing and shall remain in force unless amended or revoked.
