AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING THE MUNICIPAL CRISIS MANAGEMENT TEAM OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN, IN RESPONSE TO THE INTERNATIONAL CRISIS IN IRAN AND THE DECLARATION OF A STATE OF NATIONAL ENERGY EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the recent escalation of conflict in Iran has created significant geopolitical instability, disrupting the global supply of petroleum products and posing a direct threat to the economic stability of nations worldwide, including the Philippines;

WHEREAS, recognizing the potential for a severe energy crisis, His Excellency, President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr., has declared a State of National Energy Emergency through Executive Order No. 110 (Declaring a State of National Energy Emergency and Authorizing the Unified Package of Livelihoods, Industry, Food and Transport) mandating all government agencies, including Local Government Units (LGUs), to implement measures to mitigate the impact on the Filipino people;

WHEREAS, the adverse economic repercussions of this international crisis have now manifested locally, directly impacting the Municipality of Bayambang through significant increases in the prices of fuel, transportation, electricity, and basic commodities, thereby creating tangible hardships on the livelihood and well-being of all Bayambanguenios;

WHEREAS, the crisis also poses a significant concern for the safety and welfare of Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) from Bayambang who are residing and working in Iran and neighboring countries, and necessitates a support system for them and their families back home;

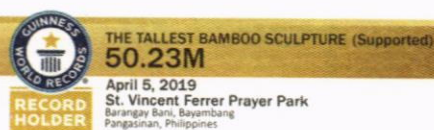
WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to create a dedicated, multi-sectoral body at the local level to orchestrate a coordinated, proactive, and effective response to manage the potential economic, social, and security challenges arising from this crisis;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. CREATION OF THE MUNICIPAL CRISIS MANAGEMENT TEAM. There is hereby created the Bayambang Municipal Crisis Management Team (CMT), which shall serve as the primary body for policy direction, coordination, and implementation of all local efforts related to the management of the crisis.

Section 2. COMPOSITION. The Municipal Crisis Management Team shall be composed of the following:

Section 3. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS. The CMT shall have the following powers and functions:

1. Formulate and implement a comprehensive Municipal Crisis Management Plan with clear protocols for response, public information, and resource allocation.
2. Serve as the central coordinating body for all crisis-related activities of municipal departments, national government agencies present in the locality, and private sector partners.
3. Monitor key local indicators, including fuel prices, supply and cost of basic commodities, public transport fares, and the status of OFW families.
4. Implement at the local level all relevant directives issued by the national government in relation to the State of National Energy Emergency.
5. Develop and execute a robust public information campaign to prevent panic, counter misinformation and disseminate vital advisories on energy conservation and government assistance programs.
6. Strengthen the dedicated OFW Help Desk under the Public Employment Services Office to monitor the situation of Bayambangueño OFWs in the conflict region and provide necessary assistance to their families.

7. Recommend the passage of local ordinances to the Sangguniang Bayan, such as those concerning anti-hoarding, anti-profiteering, and price controls, if necessary.
8. Submit regular reports to the CMT and Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG).

Section 4. ADOPTION OF NATIONAL ENERGY EMERGENCY

MEASURES. In line with the declaration by Malacañang, the CMT is hereby directed to immediately formulate and implement plans focusing on the following measures:

- a. Public Information Campaign: A widespread public awareness campaign, shall be launched targeting households and commercial establishments with clear, actionable strategies for conserving electricity and fuel.
- b. Strengthening of the Four-Day Work Week and Energy Conservation Program: The Municipality shall reinforce and expand its existing Four-Day (Monday-Thursday) Work Week schedule as a primary energy and fuel conservation measure. This policy shall be strictly enforced across all municipal government offices, with the following exceptions to ensure the continuous delivery of essential public services:
 - i. Solid Waste Management Office (for garbage collection);
 - ii. Public Market Administration;
 - iii. Bayambang Public Safety Office and other personnel in charge of maintaining peace and order; and
 - iv. Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office and Bureau of Fire Protection (for disaster preparedness and emergency response).

The Municipal Administrator is hereby directed to ensure the strict monitoring of all other departments to guarantee their full closure on Fridays, which includes powering down all non-essential electrical equipment to maximize energy savings.

- c. Price and Supply Monitoring Task Force: Activate a task force under the BPLO and the Municipal Agriculture Office to conduct daily monitoring of prices and supply of fuel, food staples, and other essential goods to immediately address any signs of hoarding, profiteering, or artificial shortages.
- d. Support for Vulnerable Sectors: Design a program for targeted assistance, such as fuel vouchers or subsidies for the local transport sector (e.g., tricycle operators and drivers) and farmers, subject to the availability of funds.

e. Food Security Assurance: Ensure the unimpeded movement of agricultural goods and support local farmers to maintain a stable food supply within the municipality.

Section 5. SECRETARIAT. The Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) shall serve as the Secretariat of the CMT, providing technical and administrative support for its operations.

Section 6. FUNDING. The initial funding for the operations of the CMT and its programs shall be charged against the Quick Response Fund (QRF) of the IGU and other available local funds, subject to government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full force and effect until the State of National Energy Emergency is lifted by the President.
