AN ORDER DECLARING A FLEXIBLE WORK ARRANGEMENT FOR OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ON APRIL 6, 2026, FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF THE TOWN FIESTA CELEBRATIONS

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bayambang will be celebrating its annual town fiesta from March 28 to April 5, 2026, which will involve a series of demanding activities and events;

WHEREAS, the successful conduct of the fiesta will require the dedicated service, extensive effort, and long hours of numerous officials and employees of the Local Government Unit (LGU) who are directly involved in the planning, preparation, and execution of the events;

WHEREAS, in recognition of their invaluable contribution and to provide them with an opportunity to rest and recuperate after the strenuous fiesta activities, it is prudent and just to grant them a day to rest and recuperate thereby ensuring their continued productivity and well-being;

WHEREAS, consistent with Civil Service Commission (CSC) Memorandum Circular No. 06 s. 2022 and other relevant issuances on alternative work arrangements, government offices may adopt flexible work arrangements, provided that the delivery of public service is not adversely affected;

WHEREAS, to ensure the continuous delivery of basic services, offices performing essential functions must maintain their normal operations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and declare the following:

Section 1. Declaration of Flexible Work Arrangement. A flexible work arrangement is hereby declared for all officials and employees of the Local Government Unit of Bayambang on Monday, April 6, 2026. Heads of departments and offices are directed to implement a work-from-home arrangement or a skeletal workforce, ensuring that personnel are given the opportunity to rest.

Section 2. Exemption of Essential Services. To ensure the continuous and unhampered delivery of critical public services, all offices and personnel involved in the following essential services shall maintain their normal operations and required staffing:
