AN ORDER CREATING A TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) ON MINING AND QUARRYING ACTIVITIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN, DEFINING ITS COMPOSITION, FUNCTIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7942, otherwise known as the “Philippine Mining Act of 1995,” mandates the state to promote the rational exploration, development, utilization, and conservation of mineral resources through the combined efforts of government and the private sector;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7076, or the “People’s Small-Scale Mining Act of 1991,” establishes a program for small-scale mining to generate more employment opportunities and provide for an equitable sharing of the nation's wealth;

WHEREAS, Section 138 of Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991) provides that the permit to extract sand, gravel, and other quarry resources shall be issued by the Provincial Governor, but the Municipality plays a vital role in the monitoring, regulation, and protection of the local environment where these activities occur;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to create a dedicated body to monitor quarrying operations, investigate reports of illegal extraction, and ensure that all activities are compliant with environmental laws to prevent siltation of waterways and damage to infrastructure;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

Section 1. COMPOSITION. The Technical Working Group (TWG) on Mining and Quarrying is hereby created and shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. FUNCTIONS. The TWG shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

1. Conduct surveillance or investigation of reported illegal quarrying activities or violations of permit conditions.
2. Support community engagement and address compliance and community impact issues.
3. Facilitate coordination with offices, agencies, and stakeholders to guarantee LGU Bayambang's adherence to national and local environment laws, and best practices.
4. Assist applicants in understanding municipal requirements and evaluate applications for Municipal Clearance prior to endorsement to the Provincial Government (PG-ENRO).
5. Endorse to PG-ENRO reported illegal quarrying and facilitate coordination with national agencies (DENR-MGB) to ensure local adherence to the Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) conditions.
6. Assist the BMPS and BPSO in the enforcement of Cease-and-Desist Orders (CDO) against illegal operators.

7. Formulate policies and prepare official reports to regulate, monitor, and manage quarry operations within the municipality, in coordination with the PG-ENRO.

Section 3. THE SECRETARIAT. The Ecological Solid Waste Management Office (ESWMO), under the leadership of the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Officer (MENRO) and assisted by its administrative staff, is hereby designated to serve as the Secretariat of the Technical Working Group (TWG). The Secretariat shall manage all administrative requirements, document all official proceedings, and maintain the records and communications essential to the operations of the TWG. In the performance of its mandate, the Secretariat shall exercise the following duties and responsibilities

1. Facilitate the preparation for and the calling of meetings as directed by the TWG.
2. Record and preserve the official minutes of all meetings and proceedings conducted by the body.
3. Prepare draft resolutions, policies, and procedural guidelines for the formal review and subsequent approval of the TWG.
4. Ensure the systematic filing and maintenance of all official communications, documents, and relevant records concerning the operations of the TWG.
5. Provide the Chairperson with necessary advice on issues and concerns relevant to the TWG to ensure the Chairperson remains fully informed of all developments.
6. Execute such other administrative tasks and functions as may be assigned by the TWG from time to time.

SECTION 4. MEETINGS AND QUORUM. The TWG shall meet at least once every quarter or as often as necessary upon the call of the Chairperson. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum to conduct official business.

SECTION 5. FUNDING. Funds necessary for the operation of the TWG, including travel expenses for field inspections, office supplies, and meeting costs, shall be sourced from the available funds of the Office of the Municipal Mayor or the MENRO, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All previous executive orders, memoranda, or local issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately.
