EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 75

RECONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND FOR SUCH OTHER RELATED PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Public Office is a Public Trust. It is a settled principle of law that municipal corporations are agencies of the State for the promotion and maintenance of local self-governance and as such are endowed with the police powers in order to effectively accomplish and carry out the declared objects of its creation;

WHEREAS, a Local Government Unit is a political subdivision of the State which is constituted by law and possessed of substantial control over its own affairs to develop not only at its own pace and discretion but also with its own resources and assets. With its broadened powers and increased responsibilities, a local government unit must now operate on a much larger scale including more extensive operations which entail more expenses;

WHEREAS, Article One, Section 444 (b) (1) (x) of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 directs executive officials and employees of the municipality to faithfully discharge their duties and functions as provided by law;

WHEREAS, Article one, Section (b) (3) (vii) of RA 7160 states that the Municipal Mayor shall initiate and maximize the generation of resources and revenues, and apply the same to the implementation of development plans, program objectives and priorities particularly those resources and revenues programmed for agro-industrial development and country-wide growth and progress through the adoption of measures to safeguard and conserve land, mined, marine, forest, and other resources of the municipality; provide efficient and effective property and supply management in the municipality; and protect the funds, credit, rights and other properties of the municipality;

WHEREAS, in order to promote efficiency and effectiveness in the delivery of services, projects and programs of the Municipality, including the protection of assets and collection of income for full utilization of resources, there is a need to create a committee to be known as the "Municipal Executive Committee" to develop, deliberate, implement development plans, program objectives, and priorities;

WHEREAS, there is a need to update the composition of the committee due to changes in officials, designations, and organizational structure to ensure that duly authorized and current representatives are properly included;

NOW THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law as the Local Chief Executive, do hereby reconstitute the **MUNICIPAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**:

SECTION 1. RECONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION. A committee in the Municipal Government of Bayambang to be known as the "Municipal Executive Committee" is hereby created to be composed of the Chairperson, a Vice-Chair-person and eight (8) Members.

The following are hereby designated as members of the Municipal Public Management Committee:

SECTION 2. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS. The Municipal Executive Committee shall exercise powers and authority to:

- Formulate development plans, program objectives and priorities for resources and revenues programmed for agro-industrial development and municipality-wide growth and progress;
- Adopt adequate measures to safeguard and conserve land, mineral, fisheries and aquatic, forest, and other resources of the municipality;
- Provide efficient and effective property and supply management in the municipality;
- Protect the funds, credits, rights, and other properties of the municipality;
- Submit recommendations to the Sangguniang Bayan for appropriate measures, resolutions, and ordinances;
- Manage, coordinate, and supervise the implementation of development plans, program objectives, and priorities, including Sangguniang Bayan resolutions and ordinances;
- Ensure the rational use of public resources efficiently and in accordance with existing laws, rules, and regulations;
- Review and evaluate the performance of municipal offices, departments, and programs to ensure effective and efficient delivery of public services;
- Serve as the primary policy-advisory and coordinating body of the Municipal Mayor on matters affecting governance, administration, and development;
- Facilitate inter-office coordination and promote collaboration among municipal departments, offices, barangays, national government agencies, civil society organizations, and other stakeholders;
- Monitor and assess the implementation of priority programs, projects, and activities of the Local Government Unit and recommend corrective measures when necessary;
- Assist in the formulation, review, and updating of local policies, administrative issuances, and operational guidelines to improve governance and public service delivery;

SECTION 3. SECRETARIAT. A Secretariat of the Municipal Executive Committee, composed by the **Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator, ENP. RYAN NICHOLAI DIZON** and three (3) staff designated by him is hereby created to assist the Committee in the exercise of its functions like the recording of its proceedings, transcribing the records of the proceedings, preparation and furnishing of notices, orders, monitoring of compliance with agreements and instructions and other processes to the concerned parties, and performing such other incidental and inherent administrative functions.

SECTION 4. COMPENSATION AND REMUNERATION. The chairperson and members of the Committee as well as its Secretariat shall perform their duties as such without any additional compensation or remuneration. However, the Municipal Budget Officer is hereby directed to allocate funds for the continuous education, trainings and seminars of concerned officers and employees in Public Management.

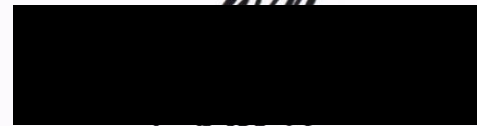
SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of the Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other orders, rules, regulations and issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Order, are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
