AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF ONE (1) LGU-OWNED AMBULANCE WITH LICENSE TO OPERATE (LTO) FROM THE BAYAMBANG PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE (BPSO) TO RURAL HEALTH UNIT I (RHU I) FOR USE IN ITS BIRTHING FACILITY AND PRIMARY CARE FACILITY OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bayambang is committed to providing accessible, quality, and responsive healthcare services to its constituents;

WHEREAS, the Rural Health Unit I (RHU I) is pursuing accreditation as a Primary Care Facility and is required to comply with the standards and requirements set by the Department of Health (DOH);

WHEREAS, one of the minimum requirements for the operation and accreditation of RHU I's Birthing Facility is the availability of an ambulance service provider for emergency transport, maternal care referrals, and other health-related emergencies;

WHEREAS, the transfer of one (1) LGU-owned ambulance with a valid License to Operate (LTO) from the Bayambang Public Safety Office (BPSO) to RHU I will facilitate compliance with DOH requirements and enhance the delivery of health services to the people of Bayambang;

WHEREAS, the said transfer will ensure the proper management, maintenance, operation, and deployment of the ambulance under RHU I, thereby improving emergency response capability, patient referral services, and overall healthcare readiness;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF AMBULANCE. One (1) LGU-owned ambulance presently assigned to the Bayambang Public Safety Office (BPSO), with a valid License to Operate (LTO), is hereby transferred and assigned to Rural Health Unit I (RHU I) for the exclusive use of its Birthing Facility and Primary Care Facility operations.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE. The transferred ambulance shall be utilized primarily for:

- Emergency medical response services;
- Maternal and newborn care referrals;
- Patient transport and inter-facility referrals; and
- Other health-related services authorized by RHU I in accordance with existing laws, rules, and regulations.

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SECTION 3. ACCOUNTABILITY AND MANAGEMENT. The Municipal Health Office through RHU I shall assume responsibility for the operation, management, maintenance, safeguarding, and proper utilization of the ambulance, including its equipment and accessories.

SECTION 4. INVENTORY AND TURNOVER. The Municipal Health Office and the Bayambang Public Safety Office shall conduct an inventory and formal turnover of the ambulance, including all attached equipment, documents, and related records, within fifteen (15) days from the effectivity of this Executive Order.

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH EXISTING RULES. The use and operation of the ambulance shall be subject to all applicable laws, Department of Health guidelines, Commission on Audit rules and regulations, and other relevant government policies.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon issuance.
