AN ORDER ASSIGNING A LICENSED AMBULANCE WITH A VALID LICENSE TO OPERATE FROM THE BAYAMBANG PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE (BPSO) TO THE RHU II BIRTHING FACILITY OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG TO STRENGTHEN EMERGENCY MEDICAL REFERRAL SERVICES AND TO COMPLY WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR A PRIMARY CARE FACILITY

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers local government units to exercise such powers as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental for the efficient and effective governance and the promotion of the general welfare, including the enhancement of health services for their constituents;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bayambang remains committed to providing quality, accessible, efficient, and responsive healthcare services to all its residents through the continuous improvement of its public health facilities and services;

WHEREAS, the Rural Health Unit II (RHU II) Birthing Facility is currently undergoing the process of securing its official licensing and accreditation as a Department of Health (DOH)-licensed Primary Care Facility in accordance with existing DOH rules, regulations, and standards;

WHEREAS, one of the mandatory requirements for the issuance of a License to Operate is the availability of a licensed emergency transport vehicle capable of safely transporting patients requiring referral to higher-level healthcare facilities;

WHEREAS, the assignment of a licensed ambulance with a valid License to Operate from the Bayambang Public Safety Office (BPSO), specifically **one (1) ambulance bearing Plate No. JJ670A**, to the RHU II Birthing Facility will ensure compliance with the DOH licensing requirements and strengthen the Municipality's emergency referral and transport system;

WHEREAS, the availability of a dedicated ambulance for RHU II will facilitate the timely referral and transport of maternal, neonatal, and other emergency patients, thereby reducing delays in emergency care and improving patient outcomes for the residents of Barangay Wawa and neighboring barangays within its service area;

WHEREAS, the Bayambang Public Safety Office (BPSO) maintains licensed ambulances that are capable of supporting the emergency medical transport requirements of the Municipality and has recommended the assignment of one (1) licensed ambulance bearing Plate No. JJ670A

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. Assignment of Ambulance.

The Bayambang Public Safety Office (BPSO) is hereby directed to assign one (1) licensed ambulance bearing Plate No. JJ670A, with a valid License to Operate, to the RHU II Birthing Facility for the primary purpose of providing emergency medical transport and referral services in support of its operations and compliance with Department of Health (DOH) licensing requirements.

SECTION 2. Purpose.

The assigned ambulance shall primarily serve the RHU II Birthing Facility in:

- a. Transporting maternal, neonatal, and emergency patients requiring referral to higher-level healthcare facilities;
- b. Supporting emergency response operations within the RHU II service area;
- c. Complying with the documentary and operational requirements prescribed by the DOH for the issuance and maintenance of a License to Operate as a Primary Care Facility; and
- d. Performing other health-related emergency transport functions as may be authorized by the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 3. Administrative Supervision.

The assigned ambulance **bearing Plate No. JJ670A** shall remain the property of the Municipality of Bayambang. Operational control for emergency medical referral services shall be exercised by the RHU II Birthing Facility, while maintenance, inventory, registration, insurance, and other administrative requirements shall continue to be coordinated with the Bayambang Public Safety Office (BPSO), unless otherwise directed by the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 4. Coordination.

The Municipal Health Office, RHU II Birthing Facility, Bayambang Public Safety Office (BPSO), General Services Office, Municipal Budget Office, and all other concerned offices are hereby directed to coordinate and undertake the necessary actions for the effective implementation of this Executive Order.

SECTION 5. Funding.

Expenses necessary for the operation, maintenance, fuel, repairs, and other incidental expenses of the assigned ambulance shall be charged against available appropriations of the Municipality, subject to existing accounting, auditing, budgeting, and procurement laws, rules, and regulations.

SECTION 6. Separability Clause.

Should any provision of this Executive Order be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. Repealing Clause.

All executive orders, office orders, memoranda, and other issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby amended, modified, or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 8. Effectivity

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its issuance.
