EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 118

AN ORDER SUSPENDING CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS IN ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN ON AUGUST 3, 2026 DUE TO TROPICAL DEPRESSION "LUIS" AND ITS ASSOCIATED WEATHER DISTURBANCES

WHEREAS, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) has issued weather advisories concerning Tropical Depression "LUIS" and the prevailing Southwest Monsoon (Habagat), which may bring rains, strong winds, and other potentially hazardous weather conditions over parts of Luzon;

WHEREAS, the prevailing and expected weather conditions associated with Tropical Depression "LUIS" and the Southwest Monsoon may pose risks to the safety and well-being of learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel, particularly those who will be travelling to and from their respective schools;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bayambang recognizes its responsibility to take precautionary measures to protect the lives and safety of its constituents, especially school children and school personnel, and to prevent possible accidents and other untoward incidents arising from hazardous weather conditions;

WHEREAS, under existing laws, rules, regulations, and Department of Education policies on the cancellation and suspension of classes during disasters, calamities, and weather disturbances, the Local Chief Executive may order the suspension of classes when prevailing conditions warrant such action for the protection of learners and school personnel;

WHEREAS, after due consideration of the latest weather information and advisories issued by PAGASA, and in the interest of public safety, there is a need to suspend classes in all levels in all public and private schools within the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order:

SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF CLASSES. All in-person and online classes in all levels, including Kindergarten, Elementary, Junior High School, Senior High School, Alternative Learning System (ALS), and other applicable educational levels, in all public and private schools within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan, are hereby **SUSPENDED** on Monday, August 3, 2026, for the entire day.

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. This Order shall apply to all learners, teaching personnel, and non-teaching personnel of public and private schools within the Municipality of Bayambang, subject to applicable national policies and issuances of the Department of Education, Commission on Higher Education, Technical Education and Skills Development Authority, and other concerned government agencies.

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SECTION 3. SAFETY AND PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES. All school heads and administrators are directed to ensure the safety and security of learners and school personnel and to undertake appropriate precautionary measures in their respective schools. Parents and guardians are likewise encouraged to ensure the safety of their children and to keep them at home during the period of class suspension, unless circumstances require otherwise.

SECTION 4. CONTINUITY OF LEARNING. School authorities shall undertake appropriate measures for the continuity of learning, consistent with existing policies and guidelines of the Department of Education and other concerned education agencies, without compromising the safety and well-being of learners and school personnel.

SECTION 5. INFORMATION DISSEMINATION. The Public Information Office, in coordination with the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO), the Municipal Government Operations Office, the DepEd Schools Division Office, and other concerned offices, is hereby directed to disseminate this Executive Order through official communication channels, social media platforms, and other appropriate means to ensure its immediate and widespread dissemination.

SECTION 6. CONTINUING MONITORING. The MDRRMO, in coordination with PAGASA, the Department of Education, the Philippine National Police, the Bureau of Fire Protection, the Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Committees, and other concerned agencies, shall continue to monitor the weather situation and undertake appropriate preparedness and response measures as may be necessary. Any subsequent suspension, resumption, or modification of classes shall be made in accordance with prevailing weather conditions, official advisories, and applicable national and local policies.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders, rules, regulations, issuances, or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon issuance and shall remain in force for the period stated herein, unless sooner lifted, modified, or extended by subsequent issuance.
