EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 119

Series of 2026

AN ORDER SUSPENDING WORK IN ALL GOVERNMENT OFFICES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN, BEGINNING AT 12:00 NOON OF AUGUST 3, 2026, DUE TO TYPHOON "LUIS," WITH EXEMPTION OF FRONTLINE AND OTHER ESSENTIAL SERVICE OFFICES

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan is currently experiencing the effects of Typhoon "LUIS", which may bring strong winds, heavy rainfall, flooding, and other hazards that could pose risks to the safety and welfare of government employees and the general public;

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety and as a precautionary measure, there is a need to suspend work in government offices within the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan, particularly during the afternoon of **August 3, 2026 (Monday)**;

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive is empowered to take necessary and appropriate measures to protect the lives, safety, and welfare of the constituents of the Municipality and to ensure the continuity of essential government services during emergencies and calamities;

WHEREAS, while the suspension of work is necessary to safeguard government employees from the possible hazards brought about by Typhoon "LUIS," **frontline, essential, emergency, disaster response, health, peace and order, and other vital services must continue to operate** to ensure the uninterrupted delivery of critical public services;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF WORK.

Work in all government offices of the Municipal Government of Bayambang, Pangasinan is hereby **SUSPENDED** effective at **12:00 NOON** of August 3, 2026 (Monday), in view of the prevailing and anticipated effects of Typhoon "LUIS."

The suspension shall cover all regular, contractual, casual, and other personnel of the Municipal Government, subject to the exemptions provided under this Executive Order.

SECTION 2. EXEMPTION OF FRONTLINE AND ESSENTIAL SERVICES.

The following offices, units, personnel, and services shall **remain operational and shall not be covered by the suspension of work**, insofar as necessary to maintain essential government functions:

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1. **Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO);**
2. **Municipal Health Office (MHO), Rural Health Units, Birthing Facilities, and other health and medical personnel;**
3. **Bayambang Public Safety Office (BPSO), including personnel performing peace and order, traffic management, and emergency response functions;**
4. **Philippine National Police (PNP) and other law enforcement and security personnel assigned within the Municipality;**
5. **Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and emergency response personnel;**
6. **Social Welfare and Development Office personnel performing emergency and disaster-related functions;**
7. **Municipal Engineering Office personnel necessary for emergency response, clearing operations, infrastructure assessment, and restoration of essential facilities;**
8. **General Services Office personnel assigned to emergency, utility, transport, equipment, and other essential support services;**
9. **Information and Communication Technology Office personnel necessary to maintain critical government communication and information systems;**
10. **Municipal Agriculture Office personnel as may be required for disaster-related agricultural assessment and response;**
11. **Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office personnel performing essential environmental and emergency functions;**
12. **Special Economic Enterprise Office and other personnel responsible for the operation of essential public facilities and services; and**
13. **Such other offices, personnel, or individuals as may be designated by the Municipal Mayor or the Municipal Administrator to perform essential, emergency, or disaster response functions.**

Heads of offices concerned shall determine and maintain only the **minimum necessary personnel** required to ensure continuity of essential services.

SECTION 3. DISASTER RESPONSE AND EMERGENCY OPERATIONS.

All concerned offices and personnel shall remain on standby and shall coordinate closely with the **MDRRMO** for emergency response, evacuation, rescue, relief, clearing operations, monitoring, public safety, and other activities necessitated by Typhoon "LUIS."

All department and office heads are likewise directed to ensure the protection and security of government properties, records, equipment, and facilities within their respective areas of responsibility.

SECTION 4. ALTERNATIVE WORK ARRANGEMENTS.

Where practicable, concerned offices may adopt appropriate **alternative work arrangements**, including work-from-home or other authorized arrangements, subject to existing Civil Service Commission rules, regulations, and applicable government policies.

Employees who are not required to report for duty shall remain reachable and available should their services become necessary for emergency or disaster-related operations.

SECTION 5. PRIVATE SECTOR.

The suspension of work under this Executive Order applies to the **Municipal Government of Bayambang and its offices and personnel**. Private companies, establishments, and offices shall exercise their own discretion regarding the suspension of work, subject to applicable laws, rules, regulations, and appropriate advisories from competent authorities.

SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE AND DISSEMINATION.

All heads of offices of the Municipal Government of Bayambang are hereby directed to immediately disseminate this Executive Order to their respective personnel and ensure strict compliance herewith.

The **Public Information Office** is likewise directed to disseminate this Executive Order through appropriate official communication channels to inform the public of the suspension of work.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY.

This Executive Order shall **take effect immediately upon issuance and shall be effective beginning at 12:00 NOON of August 3, 2026 (Monday)**, unless earlier lifted, modified, or extended by subsequent order based on prevailing weather and disaster conditions.
