EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 120

Series of 2026

DECLARING THE SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS IN BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS AND THE SUSPENSION OF WORK IN ALL GOVERNMENT OFFICES AND INSTITUTIONS DUE TO TROPICAL CYCLONE "LUIS" AND THE SOUTHWEST MONSOON ENHANCED BY TROPICAL CYCLONE "DOLPHIN" ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 04, 2026, IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan is currently experiencing inclement weather conditions brought about by **Tropical Cyclone "LUIS"** and the **Southwest Monsoon (Habagat)**, enhanced by **Tropical Cyclone "DOLPHIN"**, resulting in persistent rains, strong winds, and the possibility of flooding, landslides, and other weather-related hazards;

WHEREAS, the prevailing and forecasted weather conditions may pose risks to the safety and security of students, teaching and non-teaching personnel, government employees, and the general public, particularly those who may be required to travel to and from their respective schools and places of work;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bayambang recognizes its duty to take precautionary measures to protect the lives, safety, and welfare of its constituents and to minimize the possible adverse effects of the prevailing weather disturbance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of **Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991**, particularly those pertaining to the powers and responsibilities of the Municipal Mayor and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRPMC), the Municipal Mayor is empowered to adopt such emergency measures as may be necessary to protect life and property and maintain public safety;

WHEREAS, **Executive Order No. 66, s. 2012**, and the applicable guidelines of the Department of Education provide for the cancellation or suspension of classes and work in government offices during typhoons, flooding, other weather disturbances, and calamities, including localized suspension by the Local Chief Executive when circumstances warrant;

WHEREAS, **DepEd Order No. 037, s. 2022** provides updated guidelines on the cancellation or suspension of classes and work in schools in the event of natural disasters and other calamities, consistent with the paramount consideration of the safety and welfare of learners and school personnel;

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WHEREAS, after due assessment of the prevailing weather conditions and in the interest of public safety and as a precautionary measure, there is a need to suspend classes and government work within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Bayambang on **Tuesday, August 04, 2026**;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby promulgate and order the following:

SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF CLASSES.

All classes in **all levels, both public and private schools**, including Kindergarten, Elementary, Junior High School, Senior High School, collegiate, technical-vocational, and other educational institutions within the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan, are hereby **SUSPENDED for the whole day of Tuesday, August 04, 2026**.

The suspension is intended to ensure the safety and protection of all learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel, and other school personnel from the possible hazards associated with Tropical Cyclone “LUIS” and the enhanced Southwest Monsoon.

SECTION 2. SUSPENSION OF WORK IN GOVERNMENT OFFICES.

Work in **all offices and institutions of the Municipal Government of Bayambang** is hereby **SUSPENDED for the whole day of Tuesday, August 04, 2026**.

The suspension shall cover all regular, casual, contractual, job order, and other personnel of the Municipal Government, subject to existing laws, rules, and regulations governing attendance and compensation during suspension of work due to calamities.

SECTION 3. EXEMPTION OF ESSENTIAL AND FRONTLINER SERVICES.

The suspension of work under Section 2 shall **not apply to offices, personnel, and employees whose functions involve the delivery of essential, emergency, health, safety, security, disaster response, and other vital services**.

Accordingly, the following offices and personnel, including but not limited to the **Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO), Municipal Health Office/Rural Health Units, Emergency Medical Services/Ambulance, Bayambang Public Safety Office (BPSO), Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO), and other concerned emergency and response units**, shall remain operational as may be necessary.

Heads of offices concerned shall determine and maintain the minimum workforce necessary to ensure the continuous delivery of essential public services and emergency response.

SECTION 4. ACTIVATION AND CONTINUITY OF DISASTER RESPONSE OPERATIONS.

The **Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO)**, in coordination with the **Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC)**, shall continue monitoring the weather situation and shall undertake appropriate preparedness, response, evacuation, rescue, relief, and other disaster risk reduction and management activities as may be necessary.

All concerned offices are hereby directed to coordinate closely with the MDRRMO and other response agencies to ensure the safety and protection of the public.

SECTION 5. RESPONSIBILITY OF SCHOOL AUTHORITIES.

All public and private schools within the Municipality of Bayambang are directed to disseminate this Order to learners, parents, teaching and non-teaching personnel, and other concerned stakeholders.

School authorities shall likewise ensure that appropriate measures are undertaken to protect school facilities, equipment, records, and other properties during the period of inclement weather.

The conduct of make-up classes, alternative learning activities, and other academic arrangements, when necessary, shall be undertaken in accordance with applicable Department of Education rules and regulations.

SECTION 6. CONTINUING MONITORING OF WEATHER CONDITIONS.

The Municipal Government of Bayambang, through the MDRRMO and other concerned offices, shall continuously monitor official weather bulletins, rainfall warnings, flood advisories, and other relevant information issued by **DOST-PAGASA**.

Should weather conditions further deteriorate, the Municipal Government shall undertake such additional measures as may be necessary to protect life and property.

SECTION 7. DISSEMINATION.

This Executive Order shall be immediately disseminated through the **official communication channels of the Municipal Government of Bayambang**, including social media platforms, public announcements, barangay communication systems, and other available means, for the widest information and guidance of the public.

All Punong Barangays, school heads, government offices, concerned agencies, and other stakeholders are enjoined to assist in the immediate and effective dissemination of this Order.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY.

This Executive Order shall take effect **immediately upon issuance** and shall remain in full force and effect for the whole day of **Tuesday, August 04, 2026**, unless earlier lifted, modified, or extended by a subsequent order or official announcement based on prevailing weather and disaster conditions.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All orders, issuances, rules, regulations, or parts thereof inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby deemed modified, amended, or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.
