EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 121

AN ORDER SUSPENDING CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS IN BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN, DUE TO TYPHOON "MAYMAY"

WHEREAS, Typhoon "MAYMAY" is affecting the Municipality of Bayambang and may bring strong winds, heavy rainfall, and other hazardous weather conditions that may pose risks to the safety and well-being of learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel, and the general public;

WHEREAS, the safety and protection of learners and school personnel are of paramount importance, particularly during severe weather disturbances and other potentially hazardous situations;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to adopt precautionary measures to minimize the risks posed by the prevailing weather conditions and to ensure the safety and welfare of the school community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order:

SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF CLASSES.

Classes in all levels, in both public and private schools, are hereby suspended on August 5, 2026 (Wednesday), throughout the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan, in view of Typhoon "MAYMAY" and the inclement weather conditions it may bring.

SECTION 2. ALTERNATIVE MODES OF LEARNING.

To ensure the continuity of education, all public and private schools are encouraged to adopt appropriate alternative modes of learning, including modular, online, or other distance learning modalities, as may be applicable and consistent with existing policies and guidelines of the Department of Education (DepEd).

SECTION 3. GOVERNMENT WORK AND ESSENTIAL SERVICES.

Work in all Government Offices shall continue as usual. However, personnel performing disaster response, emergency operations, public safety, health, peace and order, and other essential services shall continue to report for duty and perform their functions as may be necessary.

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SECTION 4. SAFETY AND MONITORING.

All school heads and concerned authorities are hereby directed to take all necessary precautionary measures to ensure the safety of learners and school personnel and to continuously monitor official weather advisories, warnings, and announcements issued by PAGASA, the Department of Education, and other concerned government agencies.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon issuance and shall remain in force for the duration of the class suspension herein declared.
